* To be granted L1 certification to teach up to Nursery levels by ECDA, new teachers must have a minimum C6 grade for GCE O-Level English Language (EL1) or obtain a minimum band of 5.5 in IELTS (Academic) or other English Language Acceptable Alternatives (ELAA).
** To be certified by ECDA to teach Kindergarten levels (K1 and K2), graduates must have a minimum of a B4 grade in GCE O-Level English as a First Language (EL1) or an equivalent qualification. Students without a B4 in GCE O-Level English Language (EL1) will receive conditional certification to teach Kindergarten levels for two years. They must achieve a B4 in EL1 or an English Language Acceptable Alternative (ELAA) (e.g., IELTS 6.5) within this period, or they will be certified to teach only up to Nursery levels after the two-year conditional certification.

Upon graduation

All our full-time post-secondary courses are recognised by the Early Childhood Development Agency (ECDA) for registration to practise as an early childhood educator in Singapore.
